Meeting of the Academic Council was held on September 20, 2016 at 10:00 A.M. at the Conference Hall of Sir Sahibzada Abdul Qayyum Khan Museum of Archaeology and Ethnology which was presided over by the Vice-Chancellor. List of participants is attached as per Annexure-A.

The meeting started with recitation from the Holy Quran by Prof. Dr. Miraj ul Islam Zia, Dean, Faculty of Islamic & Oriental Studies whereafter the Vice-Chancellor welcomed the members of the Academic Council.

- (a) "Academic Council" means the Academic Council of the University of Peshawar as constituted under the University of Peshawar Act, 2011.
- (b) "Member" means a member of Academic Council.

- (d) "Chairman" means a Chairman of Academic Council, or any other person who presides at its meeting.
- (e) "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Academic Council.
- (f) All other expressions shall have the same meanings as assigned to them and as defined under Section-2 of the University of Peshawar Act, 2011.
- 4. The ordinary meeting of the Academic Council shall be held at least twice a year, one in January and the other in July on dates to be fixed by the Vice-Chancellor.
- 5. The agenda and working papers for the meeting shall be prepared by the Secretary with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor and shall be sent to the members at least fifteen days before the meeting.
- 6. If a certain matter requires an early reference to the Academic Council a special meeting of the Academic Council may be convened with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor. Agenda for such a meeting shall be circulated at least a week before the meeting.
- 7. The Vice-Chancellor shall preside at the meeting of the Academic Council. In his absence the senior most Dean by virtue of length of service in Professor's grade, shall act as the Chairman of the meeting.
- 8. The Registrar, or in his absence, the Additional Registrar or Deputy Registrar,

- The agenda and working papers for the Meeting shall be prepared by the Secretary with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor and shall be sent to the Members at least <u>ten</u> days before the Meeting.
- 6. If a certain matter requires an early reference to the Academic Council, a special Meeting of the Academic Council may be convened with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor. Agenda for such a Meeting shall be circulated at least a week before the Meeting.
- 7. The Vice-Chancellor shall preside at the Meeting of the Academic Council. In his absence, the senior most Dean, shall act as the Chairman of the Meeting.
- 8. The Registrar, or in his absence, the Additional Registrar or Deputy Registrar,

- shall act as the Secretary of the Academic Council.
- 9. Items included in the agenda or supplementary agenda may be taken up for consideration in such order as may be deemed fit by the Chairman.
- 10. The Chairman shall control the order in which members of the Academic Council may address the meeting and regulate the manner in which the business of the house may be conducted.
- 11. Member when speaking shall address the Chair. No member shall, without special leave from the Chairman, speak more than once on the same motion.
- 12. No member shall address the meeting on the motion after Chairman has called for a vote.
- 13. All matters shall be decided by simple majority of the members which will be determined by the voice-vote, show of hands for "A yes" or "No", or under special circumstances by secret ballot.
- 14. In case of a tie, the Chairman shall exercise casting vote in addition to his vote as member of the Academic Council.
- 15. Proposals submitted to the Academic Council and entered upon the notice of meeting, shall be dealt with as motions before such a meeting without being proposed and seconded.
- 16. Every other motion or resolution relating to the items on the agenda or amendment shall be reduced to writing and read out by the mover, and shall be delivered to the Secretary. Every such motion that is not seconded shall drop.
- 17. In the event of no member wishing to speak on the motion or in respect of any

- 22. The Secretary shall record the minutes and shall submit them to the Vice-Chancellor for authentication.
- 23. After the authentication of the minutes, two master copies shall be kept under lock and key in the office of the Vice-Chancellor and the Registrar. Every page of the master copies shall be signed by secretary and countersigned by the Vice-Chancellor.
- 24. Copies of the minutes shall be circulated among all the members of Academic Council before these are referred to the Syndicate for approval. The minutes should be referred to the Syndicate at

Item No.04 FEE CONCESSION TO THE EMPLOYEES OF CENTRES FUNCTIONING AT UNIVERSITY CAMPUS

A candidate of M.A/M.Sc. will avail a maximum of five and four consecutive examinations for previous and final respectively, including the initial one to clear all the papers, by scoring the required pass percentage in individual subjects as well as in aggregate, failing which he/she will be required to appear in all subjects including practical and viva-voce examinations as a whole. This decision will be applicable to both regular and private M.A/M.Sc. students as well as candidates failing in the aggregate. This decision shall be applicable from 2004 Annual.
- ii. A candidate appearing in M.A/M.Sc. exam will avail a maximum of five and four consecutive chances for previous and final respectively, including the initial one to clear all the papers, by scoring the required pass percentage in individual subjects as well as in aggregate, failing which he/she will have to reappear in the failed part by availing the prescribed chances. This decision will be applicable to both regular and M.A/M.Sc. candidates private with immediate effect.

Item No.06 AWARD OF DEGREE TO THE STUDENTS OF AFFILIATED COLLEGES IN MPH WITHOUT REGISTRATION WITH PM&DC

The Academic Council went through the recommendations of the Affiliation Committee and recommended to approve the following:

- 1. That the affiliated Institutions in MPH may be refrained from enrolling students from the Academic Session 2016-17;

The Academic Council did not accede to the request of the Public Sector Affiliated Colleges regarding granting them 100% internal assessment at par with the Teaching Departments of the University of Peshawar.

The Academic Council while going through minutes of the committee regarding starting Certificate/Diploma in Parliamentary Studies at the University of Peshawar recommended:

- 1. That the Department of Political Science shall start Certificate in Parliamentary Studies:
- 2. That the Medium of Instruction shall be English/Urdu;
- 3. That the Certificate course shall be taught in Afternoon/ Evening Class;
