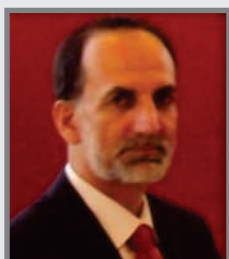

Participation in KP-Beijing Trade Roadshow:

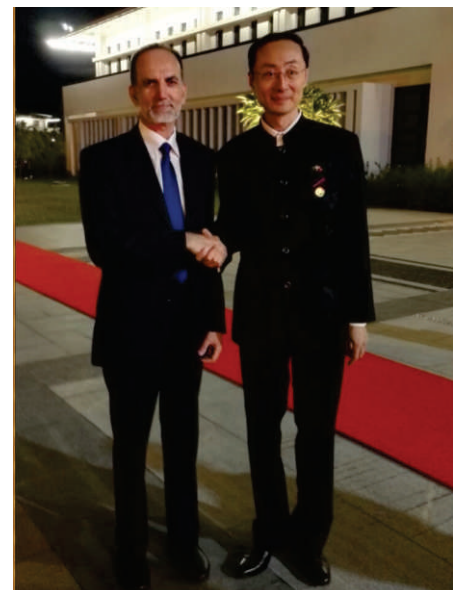

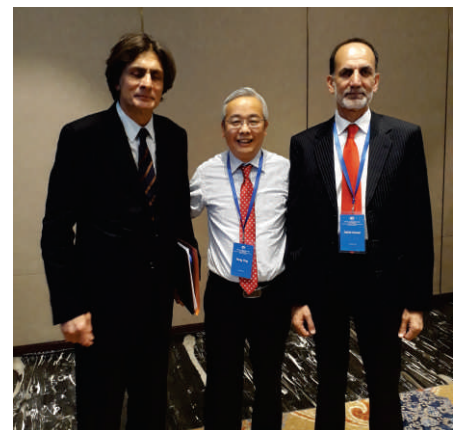
