

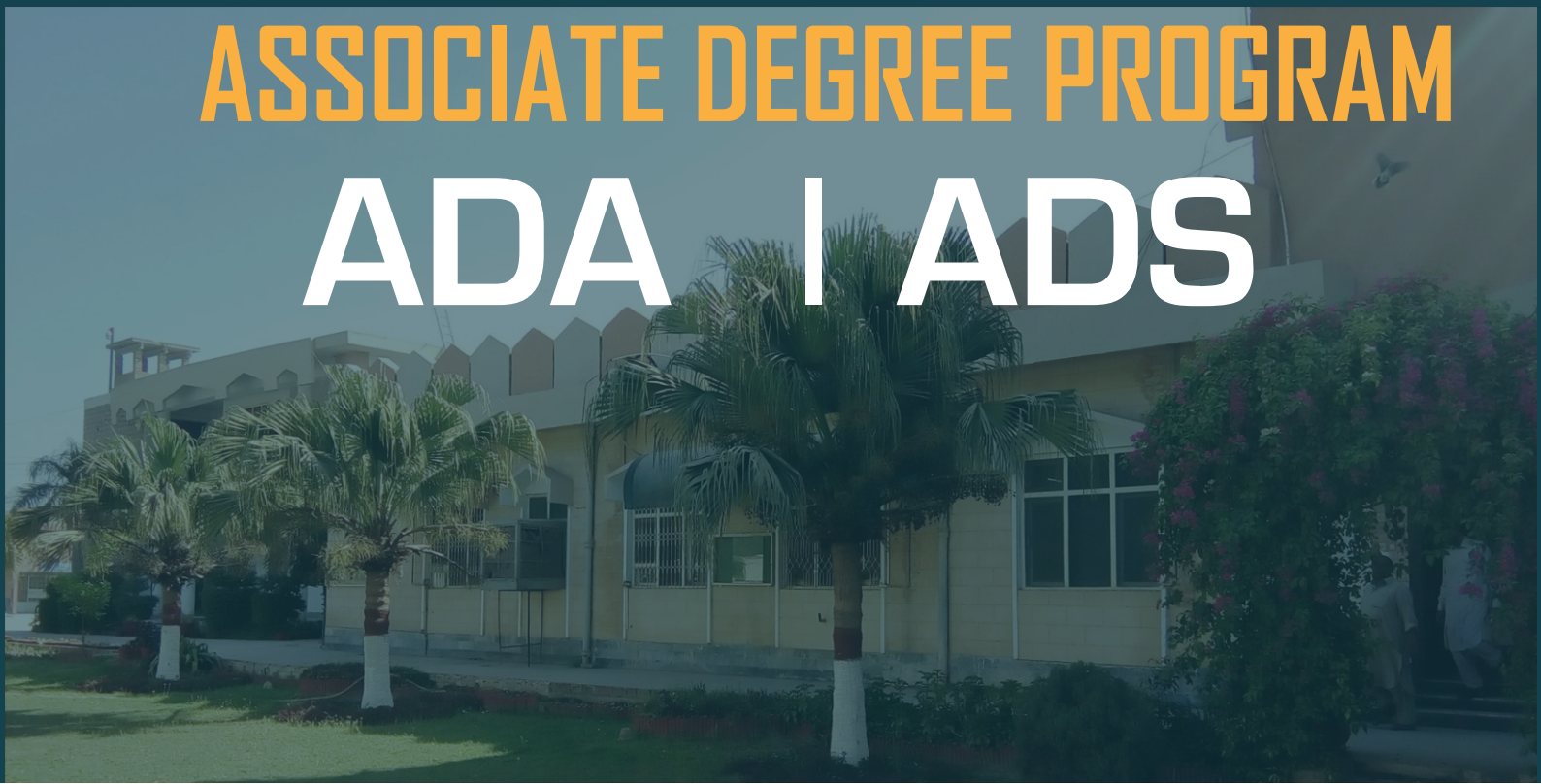

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Admission to ADS and ADA Classes shall be advertised immediately after the declaration of the Intermediate result by the khyber Pakhtunkhwa Boards and Federal Board.
- Last date of submission of forms shall be intimated by the office.
- No revised DMC shall be accepted after the display of final merit list
- Merit list shall be displayed on the notice board as well as on University official website www.uop.edu.pk.
- Admission will be finalized through the admission committee strictly on merit.
- Admission dues should be paid on the same day, after selection Delay in payment shall lead to cancellation of admission offer.
- Applicants with A-Level /Senior Cambridge certificates shall submit certificates of equivalence and conversion of marks.
- The College offers admission on open merit to all female candidates who have passed the required examination and are eligible for admission under the rules.
- Candidates who do not apply for admission by the deadline for submission of forms, or fail to appear before the admission committee for interview on the notified dates, shall not be considered for admission.
- It is the responsibility of the candidates to keep themselves informed of the date of interview / admission.

PAYMENT OF DUES

- Tuition fee, admission fee is non-refundable.
- Students are required to pay Admission Fee on the day of the interview otherwise the seat will be cancelled.
- All dues are payable in advance for each semester time of admission.
- Students promoted to next semester shall pay their dues before start of the semester.



Associate Degree is two years (4 semesters) programme to be offered, after intermediate (12 years) or equivalent education, at Jinnah College for Women, University of Peshawar. It is a two year (4-semester) associate degree program of 63-69 credit hours as an independent degree in different disciplines especially those that are market driven as per HEC's requirements.

Pathway to Further Education for Associate Degree Holders

There will be two possibilities for students after the completion of ADA/ADS

(1) They may be admitted in the University or Colleges in 5th semester with the BS students and a separate BS 2-years degree will issued to them.

OR

(2) They may be admitted in the University or colleges in two years program (BS 2-years) separately if the University start a two-year program for them.
