

Interested candidates shall submit **Online Admission Application** available at the University's official website **www.uop.edu.pk** or by visiting **http://cadmissions.uop.edu.pk** from 23rd August, 2023.

ELIGIBILITY

- ► F.Sc-I Pre-Medical: Candidates securing at least 60% marks in SSC Examination with science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics).
- ► F.Sc-I Pre-Engineering: Candidates securing at least 60% marks in SSC Examination with science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology/Computer science).
- ► FCS-I: Candidates securing at least 60% marks in SSC Examination with science subjects (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology/Computer science).
- ► F.A. Part-I: Candidates securing at least 45% marks in SSC Examination in Science and Arts subjects respectively.

NOTE: The above-mentioned eligibility criteria will also apply to all quota seats.

MOST IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

APPLICATION

- 1. Interested candidates shall submit **Online Admission Applications** at the University website **www.uop.edu.pk** or by visiting **https://cadmissions.uop.edu.pk**.
- 2. No hard copies are required submission to the admission office or Jinnah College for Women before the final merit list.
- 3. All the candidates are instructed to apply for admission well in time without waiting for the last date in order to reduce the burden on the online admission portal/website.
- 4. No printed Prospectus or Admission Application Form will be issued. The candidates are required to apply online only.
- 5. Applicants with O-Levels or Senior Cambridge Certificates shall submit equivalence and conversion of marks certificates from IBCC.
- 6. Corrections, if any, in the online admission form will be made through email requests to admissions.colleges@uop.edu.pk with proper evidence regarding requisite correction before the date of Provisional merit list i.e. 11th September 2023.
- 7. No corrections will be made once the Final merit lists are generated and displayed.

DOCUMENTS CHECK LIST AT THE TIME OF INTERVIEW

The selected candidates in the merit list (called for interview) must produce the following documents/requirements at the time of their interview:

- a. Printed Application Form
- b. Original Bank Receipt
- c. Original DMC along with a Photocopy
- d. Migration Certificate (other than BISE, Peshawar)
- e. Domicile/Form-B copy
- f. Conversion Certificate from IBCC (for O'Level students only)
- g. Service Certificate (for University Employees only)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES APPLYING ON SPORTS

- 1. The candidates must produce the following documents/requirements at the time of appearing in trials. In case of failure, the candidates shall not be allowed to participate in the trials, (It is compulsory):
 - a. Printed admission form
 - b. Two passport size photos attested on back side
 - c. S.S.C Certificate / D.M.C's (One complete set attested copy)
 - d. CNIC / Form-B and Domicile certificate (One copy attested)
 - e. Sports Certificate attested copies
 - f. Sports playing kit, two shirts (colour + white, compulsory)
- 2. Volleyball, netball, table tennis and badminton appearing for trials, the candidates must bring their own trial game equipment such as balls, rackets, shuttle cocks, etc.
- 3. The sports committee is authorized to wash any game in case of non-availability of standard or useful players for university sports.

MERIT LIST & INTERVIEWS

- 1. The merit will be determined purely on the marks obtained in Matric exam.
- 2. The admission office will prepare and post a Provisional Merit List on www.uop.edu.pk. After complaints redressal, Final Merit List will be posted on the website as per provided schedule.
- 3. Candidates on the Final Merit List must appear before the college admission committee for <u>submission of fees and copies of their documents</u> on the given dates. They should also produce all the original documents before the college admission committee for verification. If the candidate fails to do so, she will lose her chance of admission.
- 4. Admitted students (other than Peshawar Board) must submit their Migration Certificate on the day of interview. If not submitted on time they will not be registered with Peshawar Board.
- 5. No revised DMC will be accepted after 14th September 2023.
- 6. All such admission will be offered provisionally, leading to obtaining the status of regular admission, subject to the verification of all relevant documents and fulfilment of the University of Peshawar admission policy/regulations.
- 7. In case of providing wrong information or concealment of a fact by the candidate, her admission will be cancelled and the same will be offered to next candidate on merit.

- 1. Visit http://cadmissions.uop.edu.pk
- 2. Click **SIGNUP** to create your account
- 3. Login to portal using your email and password
- 4. Once you logged-in:
 - i. Complete your personal information
 - ii. Provide your academic qualification details
 - iii. Upload your recent profile picture (passport size with blue background)
 - iv. Apply for admission to your desired college, program and quota, respectively
 - v. Once you apply, print the bank voucher Rs. 2000/- and deposit the requisite amount in any United Bank Limited (UBL) branch
 - vi. Upload the scan copy of **digital bank receipt** of your deposit slip in the portal to complete the application process
- Applicants who wish to apply for more than one program or against a reserved quota seat(s) must pay an additional Rs. 2000 processing fee

IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1. Admission dues should be paid on the date of interview.
- 2. The admitted dues original bank voucher shall be presented to the College to confirm admission seat.
- 3. The college staff will scan and upload the fee voucher on the admission portal for admission seat validation.
- 4. Only 250 hostel seats are available on an academic merit basis.
