MISSION

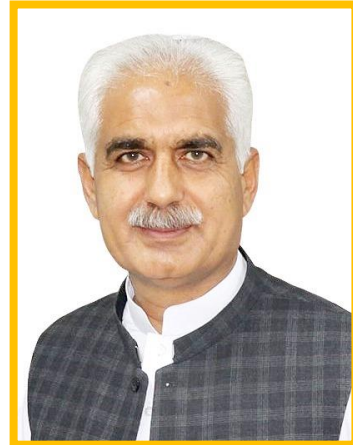

IMPORTANT NOTE: Applicants seeking admission to Botany, BBA, Economics, Electronics, English, Mathematics, Political Science, Statistics, Physics and Zoology must have studied the relevant elective/specialized subject(s) in their qualifying examination as per the prescribed eligibility criteria.

BRIDGING SEMESTER

- Students with deficiency courses will be enrolled in a bridging semester to complete these courses.
- Successful completion of the bridging semester, including passing all required deficiency courses, is mandatory for progression to the fifth semester of the BS program.

GRADING OF DEFICIENCY COURSES

- Deficient courses are mandatory to pass and will be reflected in the student's transcript.
- However, grades earned in deficient courses will not be factored into the calculation of a student's Grade Point Average (GPA) or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) for the BS program.

APPLICABILITY OF SEMESTER REGULATIONS

The Undergraduate Degree Program Regulations, 2025 are applicable to the students admitted to the fifth semester with the following adjustments:

- They will not be eligible for Gold Medal or merit positions.
- To graduate with a BS degree, they must complete a minimum of 60 to 72 credit hours (depending on the program)

8. STEP-6: Choose desired program for which admission is sought. Click Save and Next
9. STEP-7: Review your application form carefully. Click Declaration and submit form
10. Deposit Admission Processing Fee of Rs. 2,600/- through 1-Bill Online Payment (Instructions are given in the admission portal)
