

of every healthy and progressive society and nation. CHE has played a leading role in fulfilling this requirement of the nation in the NW region of Pakistan since its inception.



Initially, the University of Peshawar in collaboration with Colorado State University USA set up a separate department devoted to the subject in 1954. The department was later upgraded to the status of a College in 1963. Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II inaugurated the present building. One of the only nine Colleges in Pakistan devoted to the study of Home Economics; this college was initiated in an effort to develop a complete educational program for the preparation of young girls to meet the challenges of free society.

The institution seeks to equip young women with the specialized knowledge, skills, awareness, and the right attitude needed to launch them successfully in their social and professional lives. MOST IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

APPLICATION

- 1. Interested candidates shall submit **Online Admission Applications** at www.uop.edu.pk.
- 2. No hard copies are required submission to the admission office or College of Home Economics before the final merit list.
- 3. Applicants with O-Levels or Senior Cambridge Certificates shall submit equivalence and conversion of marks certificates from IBCC.
- 4. Corrections, if any, in the online admission form will be made through email requests to **helpdesk.oas@uop.edu.pk** with proper evidence regarding requisite correction before the date of Provisional merit list i.e. 26 August 2025.
- 5. No corrections will be made once the Final merit lists are generated and displayed.

DOCUMENTS CHECK LIST AT THE TIME OF INTERVIEW

The selected candidates in the merit list (called for interview) must produce the **following original documents and Attested photocopied documents** at the time of their interview:

- a. Detail Marks Certificate
- b. Migration Certificate (other than BISE, Peshawar)
- c. Domicile/Form-B copy
- d. Conversion Certificate from IBCC (for O'Level students only)
- e. Service Certificate (for University Employees only)

MERIT LIST & INTERVIEW

- 1. The merit will be determined purely on the marks obtained in Matric exam.
- 2. The admission office will prepare and post a Provisional Merit List on www.uop.edu.pk. After complaints redressal, Final Merit List will be posted on the website as per provided schedule.
- 3. Candidates on the Final Merit List must appear before the college admission committee for submission of fees and copies of their documents on the given dates. They should also produce all the original documents before the college admission committee for verification. If the candidate fails to do so, she will lose her chance of admission.
- 4. Admission dues should be paid on the date of interview.
- 5. A limited number of hostel seats are available on an academic merit basis.
- 6. Admitted students (other than Peshawar Board) must submit their Migration Certificate on the day of interview. If not submitted on time they will not be registered with Peshawar Board.
- 7. No revised DMC will be accepted after 26th August 2025.
- 8. All such admission will be offered provisionally, leading to obtaining the status of regular admission, subject to the verification of all relevant documents and fulfilment of the University of Peshawar admission policy/regulations.
- 9. In case of providing wrong information or concealment of a fact by the candidate, her admission will be cancelled and the same will be offered to next candidate on merit.

- 8. STEP-6: Choose desired programs AND quota for which admission is sought. Click Save and Next
- 9. STEP-7: Review your application form carefully. Click Declaration and submit form
