





ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR MS/MPHIL

Eligibility of the Candidate on the basis of Basic Academic Qualification

- Sixteen years of schooling or 4 years education (minimum 120 credit hours) after HSSC/F.A./F.Sc/Grade 12 or Equivalent.
- At least 50% passing score in GRE/GAT/HAT General/Equivalent test or University own test.

Eligibility of the Candidate on the basis of Intradisciplinary Qualification Intra-disciplinary admission may be granted to an applicant only, if:

- 1. The candidate has a strong interest in pursuing an MS/MPhil/LLM degree in a different discipline.
- 2. The candidate has passed GRE-Subject/equivalent test with minimum 50% marks in the discipline of admission and has taken 6-9 CH of deficiency courses of level 6 as per the National Qualification Framework 2015.
- 3. The GSC is satisfied that the applicant's knowledge of primary area (level 6 has sufficiently prepared the candidate to undertake the course of studies of the MS/MPhil/LLM (or, in the opinion of the GSC, the preparation can be deemed satisfactory by taking a few additional relevant courses after starting the program). The eligibility criteria for the Intra-disciplinary admission shall be determined by the GSC of the concerned department.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PHD

Eligibility Criteria for Admission

- Candidates possessing MS/MPhil/LLM (Research-based/minimum 18 years of education)/ equivalent degree with at least CGPA of 3.0 (out of 4 in semester system) or 1st Division (in annual system).
- Candidates possessing MS Course-based (minimum 18 years of education)/equivalent degree with at least CGPA of 3.0 (out of 4 in semester system) or 1st Division (in annual system), and having one published research article in HEC recognized journals (at least 'Y' category) as principal or corresponding author.
- If the CGPA/Percentage is not mentioned on the transcript, the candidate must produce equivalent weightage from the parent University.

Eligibility of the Candidate on the basis of Intradisciplinary Qualification

Intradisciplinary admissions may only be allowed, if:

- The applicant has a strong interest in pursuing a PhD in a different discipline.
- The applicant has passed GRE-Subject/Equivalent Test with minimum 50% marks in the discipline of admission and has taken 6-9 CH of deficiency courses of level 7.
- The GSC is satisfied that the applicant's knowledge of the primary area (level 7) has sufficiently prepared him or her to undertake the course of study of the doctoral program (or, in the opinion of the GSC, the preparation can be deemed satisfactory by taking a few additional courses after starting the program..



- Certificate from the concerned Department/Organization before his/her Provisional Admission.
- Provision of hostel accommodation is subject to availability of seats and shall not be claimed as a matter of right.
- If found ineligible in scrutiny, the candidate shall not be allowed to appear in the Interview even he/she has qualified the GRE-SUBJECT/GRE/GAT/HAT General/Equivalent test or departmental Test. Further, if the candidate appeared in the interview and later found to be ineligible for any reason,
- his/her admission will be cancelled at any stage.
 In case of ambiguity about eligibility/program, the opinion of the Graduate Stud-

The selected candidates in the merit list (called for interview) must produce the following documents/requirements at thetime of their interview:

- a. Relevant Degree & Transcript/DMC (Original) along with a Photocopy
- **b.** CNIC Copy
- **c.** Valid GRE-SUBJECT/GRE/GAT/HAT General/Equivalent test scorecard with a photocopy, (For students who qualified it)
- **d.** Service Certificate (for University Employees only)

HOW TO APPLY

- 2. Click Undergraduate Admission Fall 2025 and Click Apply Online. (It is advisable to see How to Apply tutorial or watch a short video, available on the same link).
 - **STEP-1**: Create your Account

 - STEP-3: Click on desired degree program to apply
 - **STEP-4**: Enter your Personal Information and Upload your recent profile picture (passport size with blue background). Click Save and Next
 - STEP-5: Enter your qualification details. Click Save and Next
 - **STEP-6**: Choose desired programs AND quota for which admission is sought. Click Save and Next
 - **STEP-7**: Review your application form carefully. Click Declaration and submit form
