HOW TO APPLY

1. Visit <http://www.uop.edu.pk>
2. Click Undergraduate Admission Fall 2025 and Click Apply Online.
(It is advisable to see How to Apply tutorial or watch a short video, available on the same link).
3. STEP-1: Create your Account
4. STEP-2: Once registered, Login to the portal using your email and password
5. STEP-3: Click on desired degree program to apply
6. STEP-4: Enter your Personal Information and Upload your recent profile picture (passport size with blue background). Click Save and Next
7. STEP-5: Enter your qualification details. Click Save and Next
8. STEP-6: Choose desired programs AND quota for which admission is sought. Click Save and Next
9. STEP-7: Review your application form carefully. Click Declaration and submit form
10. Deposit Admission Processing Fee of Rs.2,600/- through 1-Bill Online Payment (Instructions are given in the admission portal)

MOST IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fee structure and admission entrance test related information will be notified soon on www.uop.edu.pk.
2. The merit criteria for undergraduate admissions is; SSC Marks: 20%, HSSC or Equivlent Marks: 30% and Admission Test Score: 50%
3. If HSSC results have not been declared, the merit will be determined based on first-year marks as per approved eligibility. Applicants admitted on this basis cannot claim merit adjustments after the results are declared.
4. Admissions based on first-year marks will remain provisional until the declaration of intermediate examination results. Those who do not pass the HSSC examination or meet the minimum eligibility criteria will not be eligible for admission, and their fees will be refunded in accordance with the University's refund policy.
5. For admission to the LLB (5-Years) program, passing the Law Admission Test (LAT) is compulsory.
6. Revised DMC and changes to program(s) are not permissible after closing date.
7. Candidates applying under a prescribed quota must provide documentary evidence at the time of admission interviews in order to justify their eligibility for such quota, as deemed appropriate.
8. If the number of students admitted to a prozgram is fewer than 15, the admissions to the said program will be considered cancelled.
9. All admissions are provisional, subject to the verification of required documents and transcripts during the admission interviews, as well as compliance with admission regulations and policies. Any incorrect, false, or hidden information provided by the applicant will result in disqualification.
10. The University reserves the right to withdraw any program, modify the rules governing programs, or make necessary amendments to programs or courses of study where deemed necessary.
