Summary

As an Associate Professor of International Relations at the University of Peshawar, I bring 19 years of teaching and research experience, with a PhD from the same institution. My PhD research was conducted at Georgetown University in the USA, where I examined the “Evangelicals on US Foreign Policy: Impact on Pakistan – US Relations (September 2001-November 2007).” My research informed my numerous national and international publications covering religion, politics, security, religious extremism, terrorism and gender issues. I have contributed to global conferences, earning multiple awards for my scholarly contributions, such as the CWFL Fellowship Award, the US State Department’s SUSI Program. Additionally, I actively participate in academic publishing as an editor and reviewer for several journals and books.
