RESEARCH PROJECTS:

I have been able to earn research funding as PI and Co-PI worth **Billions of Rupees** from a variety of national and international funding agencies. These include my current projects on control of Tuberculosis (1.2 billion), treatment of First Episode Psychosis (70 million), and Gender equity in global health research (worth 5 million). Previously, I have worked as PI of three research projects funded by HEC (worth over 100 million). Earlier, I secured over 50 million on research projects related to CPEC, counter terrorism, child protection, and women's empowerment. Overall, I have contributed Millions of Rupees to the University of Peshawar from external sources.

I have organized several conferences and presented my scholarly work in over two dozens of international conferences across the world, including UK, France, Germany, Thailand, Italy, and Afghanistan. In addition, I have organized four international conferences as Chief Organiser.
